

Budget/ Expenditure


• Make a list of all possible items/resources (wishlist)- contact local suppliers/organisations that may be interested in donating goods or services. (If you can, look at Aboriginal Organisations where possible).

 Things to consider: student learning programs, earthworks, materials, labour, RFF time, maintenance-composting, watering system.

Choosing your location-things to consider

- What is already there that you may be able to use? eg- established trees (shade).
- Location what will the space be used for, does it need to be in a quiet/central part of school?
- Accessibility- Can <u>all</u> students access the garden.
- Contour of land- Will your site require excavation/earthworks?
- Can trucks get access to your site? Is it easy to move materials to that spot?

- Find plans of school- This may be difficult!
- Identify risks Develop a Risk Assessment/Management Plan-Principal
- Submit Request for Works with Asset Management-Principal
- They will get back to you with approval or things to consider
