EARTH IS OUR HOME, LET'S SAVE IT



Rumbalara will be offering a High Potential and Gifted Education program in 2025. The program will cater for HPGE students with diverse needs, providing meaningful and engaging activities to extend their intellectual, creative and social-emotional abilities.

How does it work?

Schools are invited to send 4-6 Stage 2 students to participate in the program during the school year. The program will include 3 Workshop Days at Rumbalara EEC (or another location). Additionally, some time will be required to work on the project during school time.

Students will examine a local unique ecological community. The program is hands-on, allowing students to collaborate and use critical thinking to uncover the unique interactions between animals and their environment.

Participating students will be provided with the opportunity to meet an ecologist, use specialised scientific equipment and conduct field work.

Expression of Interest will be distributed to schools. Principals and teachers are asked to identify suitable students to participate in this program.

A small fee will be charged for students to participate in the HPGE Days – one in Term 1, Term 2 and Term 3 (\$15 per student for each day i.e. \$45 total per student).
