










The average Central Coast school throws away ~30kgs of food every day.







That's the equivalent of 150 vegemite sandwiches.










Or 430 apples!

1.2 million tonnes


of food each year.

- Time spent buying and preparing it
- Opportunities to educate our students to solve environmental issues
